



WILDLIFE REHABILITATION



Our wildlife rehabilitation camp is 100% interactive and teaches youth the daily responsibilities of working at a wildlife rehabilitation centre. Taught by a wildlife experts, campers will learn how to prepare nutrition for sick and injured animals, observe physical exams, learn about medical care, build enrichment items, species specific husbandry, wildlife disease and much more. Campers will also take an active role in the environmental assessment of release sites for those animals who have completed their stay at the centre.

LEADERS IN TRAINING *

Youth will work in a 2:1 ratio, shadowing the wildlife rehabilitation supervisor and gaining first hand experience on wildlife rehabilitation. At the completion of this program, successful campers are able to volunteer at the wildlife rehabilitation centre towards their community hours for school!
